- (c) On all apple varieties, with the exception of Cox's Orange Pippin and Sturmer Pippin thin net-like or tracery russet is permitted provided-
  - (i) It does not contrast strongly with the general colouring of the fruit; and
  - (ii) The aggregate area of thin net-like russet alone or in combination with solid patches of smooth russet does not exceed the maximum percentage specified in the table to clause 3 (b) of the Second Schedule to this notice, and is not spread over more than 20 percent of the surface of the fruit.

On Cox's Orange Pippin, and Sturmer Pippin, and all pear varieties there is no restriction of the percentage of the fruit surface area carrying thin net-like russet.
