Grehan Stream ..	Flows along northern side of Rue Grehan into Childrens Bay. Map reference, S. 94/2922.
Holmes Stream ..	Stream which flows into Holmes Bay. Map reference, S. 84/2238.
Hukahuka Turoa Stream ..	Flows from "Waipuna Saddle" to junction of Opuahou Stream and Okana River. Map reference, S. 94/1427.
Kinloch Stream ..	Tributary of Okuti River. Map reference, S. 94/1424.
Knight Stream ..	The main stream flowing into Lavericks Bay. Map reference, S. 85/4032.
Le Bons Stream ..	The main stream flowing into Le Bons Bay. Map reference, S. 95/4029.
Menzies Stream ..	The main stream flowing into Menzies Bay. Map reference, S. 84/2841.
Menzies Bay ..	The bay between Manuka Bay and Otouhuao Head. Map reference, S. 84/2942. Also known as "McIntosh Bay".
Narbey Stream ..	The main stream flowing into Otanerito Bay. Map reference, S. 95/3618.
Nikau Palm Gully ..	The first gully north-west of Dan Rodgers Creek. Map reference, S. 94/2814.
Opara Stream ..	The main stream flowing into Okains Bay. Map reference, S. 85/3735.
Owhetoro Stream ..	The stream which flows alongside Richfield Road with outlet in Port Levy (inlet). Map reference, S. 84/1639.
Pawsons Stream ..	The stream which flows along the western side of Pawsons Valley Road to Duvau-chelle Bay. Map reference, S. 94/2629.
Pigeon Bay Stream ..	The main stream which flows into the head of Pigeon Bay. Map reference, S. 84/2336.
Pile Bay ..	For the bay just east of Ripapa Island. Map reference, S. 84/1144. Instead of "Shelly Bay" shown on maps.

Prices Stream ..	The main stream in Prices Valley. Map reference, S. 94/0223.
Purau Stream ..	The main stream which flows into Purau Bay. Map reference, S. 84/1042.
Raupo Stream ..	The northern stream flowing into Raupo Bay. Map reference, S. 85/3539.
Starvation Gully ..	For the gully along the northern side of Starvation Gully Road. Map reference, S. 84/2336.
Te Kawa Stream ..	The stream which flows along the south-eastern side of the Port Levy - Little River Road. Map reference, S. 84/1639.
Te Oka Stream ..	The main stream flowing into Te Oka Bay. Map reference, S. 94/1217.
