Defining the Middle Line of a Portion of the Dunedin-Milton Motorway in the City of Dunedin

#### **DENIS BLUNDELL**, Governor-Genera! A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to section 4 of the Public Works Amendment Act 1947, I, Sir Edward Denis Blundell, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby proclaim and declare that the middle line of a portion of the Dunedin-Milton Motorway shall be that defined and set forth in the Schedule hereto; and I also declare that this Proclamation shall affect only the lands situated within the limits of the area shown coloured red on plan S.O. 18397, referred to in the said Schedule.

#### SCHEDULE

#### OTAGO LAND DISTRICT

COMMENCING at a point on the south-western boundary of Lot 13, Deeds Plan 65, '16 metres from the western corner of that lot; proceeding thence in a south-westerly direction generally for a distance of 200 metres approximately, passing in, into, through, or over the following roads, streets, ways, highways, or lands (which have been taken for better utilisa-tion by the *Gazette* notices numbered hereunder) etc., viz: Tay Street, Lots 2 and 3, D.P. 8809 (G.N. 433064), Lot 1, D.P. 8809 (G.N. 276099), part Lot 8, Deeds Plan 65 (G.N. 276100), parts Lot 7, Deeds Plan 65 (G.N. 317598), parts Lot 5, Deeds Plan 65 (G.N. 298169 and 332135), Grosvenor Street, and terminating at a point on the north-western boundary and terminating at a point on the north-western boundary of Lot 36, Deeds Plan 65, 5 metres from the western corner of that lot in Block VII, Town District, City of Dunedin. As the same is delineated on plan S.O. 18397, lodged in the office of the Chief Surveyor at Dunedin.
