Land Taken for Street and for Sanitary Works (Disposal of Refuse) in the City of Wellington

A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to the Public Works Act 1928, I, Sir Edward Denis Blundell, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby proclaim and declare that the land described in the First Schedule hereto is hereby taken for street and that the land described in the Second Schedule hereto is hereby taken for sanitary works (disposal of refuse) and that the said pieces of land shall vest in the Mayor, Councillors, and Citizens of the City of Wellington as from the date hereinafter mentioned; and I also declare that this proclamation shall take effect on and after the 25th day of March 1976.

FIRST SCHEDULE

WELLINGTON LAND DISTRICT

ALL that piece of land containing 2036 square metres, situated in Block X, Port Nicholson Survey District, being part Lot 1, D.P. 25110; as shown on plan S.O. 30121 lodged in the office of the Chief Surveyor at Wellington, and thereon marked "A".
