ORDER

1. This order shall come into force on 1 April 1976.

2. The Waipa Drainage Board shall be dissolved and the Waipa Drainage District shall be abolished.

3. The area of the Waipa Drainage District shall be con-stituted a drainage district of the County of Otorohanga under the name of the "Waipa Drainage District" (or such other name as the Otorohanga County Council may decide to adopt).

4. The Waipa Drainage District shall be deemed to have been constituted under Part XVI of the Counties Act 1956, and the classifications of land for rating purposes made by the Waipa Drainage Board and existing on its dissolution shall be the classifications of land in the Waipa Drainage District as if those classifications had been made under that part of that Act.

5. The assets and liabilities of the Waipa Drainage Board shall vest in the Otorohanga County Council, and the assets shall, after all liabilities have been provided for, be applied only to land drainage in the Waipa Drainage District and any amounts requiring to be found to meet those liabilities shall be found only within that district.
