SPECIAL ORDER

THE Auckland Regional Authority in exercise of the powers vested in it by the Auckland Regional Authority Act 1963, section 37, and in pursuance of the authority conferred upon it under the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, and in exercise of all other powers enabling it on that behalf doth hereby resolve by special resolution intended to operate as a special order to borrow the sum of four million dollars (\$4,000,000) to be known as Transport Loan No. 10, 1975, \$4,000,000 for the purposes of and incidental to financing the Authority's bus replacement programme during the 1976-81 period.

The foregoing special order was passed at an ordinary meeting of the Auckland Regional Authority held, on 16 February 1976, and confirmed at an ordinary meeting of the said Authority held, on 15 March 1976, having meantime been advertised in the *Auckland Star*, on Saturday, 21 February 1976, and Saturday, 6 March 1976.
