*National Roads Board—Notice Partially Revoking Declaration of State Highway to be a Limited Access Road*

PURSUANT to subsection (5) of section 4 of the Public Works Amendment Act 1963, the National Roads Board hereby revokes its resolution of 16 October 1974\*, pursuant to section 4 of the Public Works Amendment Act 1963, declaring that part of No. 2 State Highway (Pokeno-Wellington) from the southern boundary of Greytown Borough to the boundary of Featherston Borough, as more particularly shown on Sheets 1 and 2 of Plan M.O.W. 36416, and accompanying Schedule, held in the office of the Resident Engineer, Ministry of Works and Development, Masterton, and there available for public inspection, to be a limited access road in so far as it affects that part of No. 2 State Highway for half its width over a distance of 20 metres southward from the junction of the north-east boundary of part Lot 2, D.P. 2952 (C.T. 9B/1338), with the State highway boundary.
