- (d) Tailrace to Six Mile Creek.
- 3. (a) Headworks, consisting of an intake on the Maruia River, giving a static head of approximately 22 ft.
- (b) A race leading to the powerhouse hereinafter referred to.
- (c) Powerhouse, with water turbine and all necessary equipment for generating electricity, having a maximum capacity of 150 kilovolt amperes.
- (d) Tailrace to the Maruia River.
- 4. The water shall be taken from:
- (a) The tributary of the Riwaka River at a point in Section 3, Block I, Motueka Survey District.

- (b) The Brooklyn River at a point between Sections 30 and 31, Block II, Motueka Survey District.
- (c) The Six Mile Creek at a point in Section 7, Block IX, Tutaki Survey District.
- (d) The Maruia River at a point in Section 6, Block VIII, Maruia Survey District.
