#### *The Traffic (Kawerau Borough) Notice No. 1, 1976*

PURSUANT to the Transport Act 1962, the Minister of Transport hereby gives the following notice.

#### NOTICE

1. This notice may be cited as the Traffic (Kawerau Borough) Notice No. 1, 1976.

2. The roads specified in the First Schedule hereto are hereby excluded from the limitation as to speed imposed by section 52 of the Transport Act 1962.

3. The roads specified in the Second Schedule hereto are hereby declared to be 70-kilometres-an-hour speed limit areas for the purposes of regulation 27A of the Traffic Regulations 1956\*.

4. The Traffic (Kawerau Borough) Notice No. 1, 1971, dated the 20th day of October 1971†, under section 52 of the Transport Act 1962, and regulation 27A of the Traffic Regulations 1956\*, which relates to roads situated within Kawerau Borough is hereby revoked.

#### FIRST SCHEDULE

SITUATED within Kawerau Borough:

East Bank Road: from Tamarangi Drive to the bridge across the Tarawera River.

Fentons Mill Road: from the southern boundary of Kawerau Borough to Glasgow Street.

Glasgow Street: from Fentons Mill Road to a point 160 metres measured westerly generally along Glasgow Street from Bell Street.

 Tamarangi Drive.

#### SECOND SCHEDULE

SITUATED within Kawerau Borough:

Tamarangi Drive: from a point 240 metres measured north-easterly generally along the said drive from Islington Street to a point 240 metres measured south-westerly generally along the said drive from the said street.
