### PUBLIC WORKS ACT 1928

PURSUANT to section 22 of the Public Works Act 1928, the Stewart Island County Council hereby gives notice of its intention to take, on or after the 27th day of August 1976, the land, described in the Schedule hereto, for the purpose of constructing thereon a public work, namely, a refuse tip. Any person affected by the taking of the land who wishes to object thereto, not being an objection to the amount or payment of compensation, should set forth such objection in writing and send the same to the Town and Country Planning Appeal Board on or before the 26th day of August 1976. If any such objection is made a public hearing will be held, unless the objector otherwise requires, and every objector will be advised of the time and place of such hearing.
