

- (b) To lay and construct a stormwater drain or drains of such dimensions as the authority shall determine and, from time to time, alter or reconstruct the same, and to clean or otherwise maintain the same in a state of efficiency, subject to the condition that as little disturbance as possible is caused to the surface of the land of the grantor, and that the surface is restored as nearly as possible to its original condition and any other damage done by reason of the aforesaid alterations is repaired.
- (c) To delegate to the local council, as defined by the Waikato Valley Authority Act 1956, the rights and powers under this easement.
- (d) Such rights and privileges to be in common with the registered proprietor for the time being of the lands, described in the Second Schedule hereto, and in common with the registered proprietor for the time being of the land comprised in certificate of title, Volume 8B, folio 709, Wellington Registry, being part Hautu 3F4B1 or any part thereof, and their respective servants, agents, workmen, visitors, and all persons having business with them or any of them.
3. On the land in the Second Schedule or part thereof being dedicated as a public road the rights hereby created over that portion of the land in the Second Schedule as shall be so dedicated shall be cancelled.
