Licensing B. F. Candy and K. L. Morrison Pty Ltd. to Occupy a Site for a Boat Ramp and Sewer Outfall at Amodeo Bay, Coromandel Peninsula

PURSUANT to section 162 of the Harbours Act 1950, I, Owen John Conway, of the Ministry of Transport, in exercise of powers delegated by the Minister of Transport, hereby license and permit B. F. Candy and K. L. Morrison Pty Ltd. (hereinafter called the licensee, which term shall include its successors or assigns unless the context requires a different construction) to use and occupy a part of the foreshore and bed of the sea at Amodeo Bay, Coromandel Peninsula, as shown on plans marked MD (N) 212 and MD (N) 213 and deposited in the office of the Ministry of Transport at Auckland for the purpose of maintaining thereon a boat ramp and sewer outfall, as shown on the said plans, such licence to be held and enjoyed by the licensee upon and subject to the terms and conditions set forth in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

CONDITIONS

(1) This licence is subject to the Foreshore Licence Regulations 1960, and the provisions of those regulations shall, so far as applicable, apply hereto.

(2) The term of the licence shall be 14 years from the 1st day of August 1976.

(3) The premium payable by the licensee shall be forty dollars (\$40) and the annual sum so payable by the licensee shall be one hundred and eighty dollars (\$180); provided always that the Minister may review the annual sum payable at the end of the first year or any subsequent year of the said term.

(4) The boat ramp shall be available for the use of all persons free of charge at all reasonable times.
