The Traffic (Southland County) Notice No. 1, 1976

PURSUANT to the Transport Act 1962, the Minister of Transport hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

1. This notice may be cited as the Traffic (Southland County) Notice No. 1, 1976.

2. The roads, specified in the First Schedule hereto, are hereby declared to be closely populated localities for the purposes of section 52 of the Transport Act 1962.

3. The roads, specified in the Second Schedule hereto, are hereby declared to be 70-kilometres-an-hour speed limit areas for the purposes of regulation 27A of the Traffic Regulations 1956*.

4. The Traffic (Edendale Town District) Notice No. 1, 1974, dated the 19th day of April 1974†, under section 52 of the Transport Act 1962, and regulation 27A of the Traffic Regulations 1956*, which relates to roads situated within the Edendale Town District is hereby revoked.

FIRST SCHEDULE

SITUATED within Southland County at Edendale:

No. 1 State Highway (Awanui-Bluff): from a point 300 metres measured northerly along the said State highway from Ferry Road to a point 480 metres measured westerly generally along the said State highway from Bath Lane.

Edendale-Seaward Downs Road: from Ferry Road to a point 100 metres measured southerly generally along Seaward Downs Road from Turner Street.

The Matamata College Board of Governors Notice 1976

PURSUANT to section 50 of the Education Act 1964, the Minister of Education gives the following notice.

NOTICE

1. (1) This notice may be cited as the Matamata College Board of Governors Notice 1976.

(2) This notice shall come into force on the first day of October 1976.

2. The Board of Governors of Matamata College shall be constituted as follows:

(a) One member appointed by the South Auckland Education Board;

(b) One member elected by the teachers of the school;

(c) Six members elected by the parents of pupils attending the school;

(d) One member appointed by the Matamata Borough Council;

(e) One member appointed by the Matamata and Piako County Councils jointly;

(f) One member co-opted by the Board of Governors itself, if and when it thinks fit.

3. This notice is in substitution for the Matamata College Board of Governors Order 1957*.
