Redefining the Boundaries of the Te Kuiti Abattoir District and Notifying the Change of Name of the Controlling Authority of the Te Kuiti Abattoir, the Te Kuiti Abattoir District, and the Te Kuiti Abattoir (No. 1526 Ag. 15/10/2/40)

PURSUANT to section 15 (5) of the Meat Act 1964, and to a delegation from the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries for the purpose of the said subsection, notice is hereby given as follows:

- 1. The Te Kuiti Abattoir District, and the Te Kuiti abattoir shall henceforth be called the Waitomo Abattoir District, and the Waitomo abattoir, respectively.
- 2. The Waitomo District Council shall henceforth be the controlling authority of the abattoir vice the former Te Kuiti Borough Council.
- 3. The Waitomo Abattoir District shall henceforth comprise all the area in the Waitomo District, as from time to time constituted, but excluding the Pio Pio community and also all that area within a distance of 5 kilometres from the boundary of the Pio Pio community.

This notice is given as a consequence of the amalgamation of the Borough of Te Kuiti and the County of Waitomo, on April 1 1976, to form the Waitomo District.
The notice No. 84, dated the 10th day of December 1968, redefining the boundaries of the Te Kuiti Abattoir District, and published in the Gazette on the 19th day of December 1968, at page 2426, is hereby consequentially revoked.
