NOTICE is hereby given that the Wanganui City Council proposes, under the provisions of the Public Works Act 1928, to take a water pipeline easement for a 21-inch diameter water main and additional rights incidental thereto as more particularly described in the First and Second Schedules hereto; and Notice is hereby further given that a plan of the easement required is deposited in the Public Office of the Town Clerk of the said city in St. Hill Street, Wanganui, and is open for inspection without fee by all persons during ordinary office hours; and that all persons directly affected by the taking of the said easement should, if they have any objections to the taking of the said easement (not being an objection to the amount of payment of compensation), must state their objection in writing and send the same to the Secretary, Town and Country Planning Appeals Board, P.O. SECOND SCHEDULE

1. That the Wanganui City Council shall have the full, free, uninterrupted, and unrestricted right, liberty, and privilege from time to time and at all times to convey water along the stipulated course across the land as delineated in the above-mentioned plan.
2. That the Wanganui City Council shall have the full, free, uninterrupted, and unrestricted right, liberty, and privilege to use any line of pipes already laid on the stipulated course or any pipe or pipes in replacement or in substitution for all or any of those pipes.
3. In order to maintain the efficiency of any such pipeline the said council's servants, agents, and workmen shall have the full, free, uninterrupted, and unrestricted right, liberty, and privilege together with any tools, implements, machinery, vehicles, or equipment of whatsoever nature necessary for the purpose to enter upon the land over which this easement is taken by such route as is reasonable in the circumstances and to remain there for the purpose of laying, inspecting, cleansing, repairing, maintaining, and renewing the pipeline or part thereof and of opening up the soil of that land to such an extent as may be necessary and reasonable in that regard subject to the condition that as little disturbance as possible is caused to the surface of the land and that the surface is restored as nearly as possible to its original condition and any damage done by reason of the aforesaid operation is repaired.
