Declaring Land Used as a Roadway in Blocks X and XI, Russell Survey District, Bay of Islands County, to be Road

PURSUANT to section 422 of the Maori Affairs Act 1953, I, Sir Edward Denis Blundell, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby declare the land described in the Schedule hereto, and used as a roadway, to be road, and to be vested in the Chairman, Councillors, and Inhabitants of the County of Bay of Islands.

State Forest Land Set Apart as State Forest Park

DENIS BLUNDELL, Governor-General A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS Her Majesty the Queen by Proclamation, dated the 28th day of February 1977, and published in the New Zealand Gazette, No. 23, on 3 March 1977, page 445, set apart in the Nelson Conservancy of the New Zealand Forest Service certain State forest land, described in the Schedule thereto, as a State forest park to be known as the Mount Richmond State Forest Park, and directed that the said Proclamation should come into force on the 4th day of March 1977, and whereas the area of land thirdly described in the schedule of the Proclamation was stated as 33.0563 hectares, and whereas the correct area of the said land is 333.0563 hectares, now, therefore, pursuant to section 21 of the Forests Act 1949, I, Sir Edward Denis Blundell, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby proclaim that the area of land thirdly described in the afforesaid Proclamation, dated the 28th day of February 1977, is hereby amended to read 333.0563 hectares,
