Fennel (Foeniculum vulgare). Gorse (Uliex, any species). Hemlock (Conium maculatum).

Japanese wineberry (Rubus phoenicolasius).

Johnson grass (Sorghum halepense).

Nodding thistle (Carduus nutans).

Ragwort (Senecio jacobaea). Scotch thistle or Plume thistle (Cirsium lanceolatum).

Sweet briar (Rosa eglanteria syn. Rosa rubiginosa).
Wild tulip (Brassica campestris).
Winged thistle (Carduus teneuflorus and Carduus pycnoce-

phalus).

Woolly nightshade (Solanum auriculatum).
