PURSUANT to section 221A (16) of the Sale of Liquor Act 1962, as amended by the Sale of Liquor Amendment Act 1976, I, Gordon Stewart Orr, Secretary for Justice, hereby give notice that the Waikato Licensing Committee on 22 September 1977 made orders authorising variations of the usual hours for the sale of liquor to chartered club members, and further authorised the following hours of trading for the chartered club premises specified in the Schedule below:

- (a) On every Friday and Saturday (not being New Year's Eve nor days on which chartered clubs are required by law to be closed for the sale of liquor to their members) and also on Christmas Eve, the hour of closing to be not later than 11 o'clock in the evening.
- (b) On every New Year's Eve (not being a day on which chartered clubs are required by law to be closed for the sale of liquor to their members) the hour of closing to be not later than 0.30 o'clock in the morning of New Year's Day.
- (c) With the condition that the licensee makes provision for the supply of food—and the committee suggests sandwiches and pies—up until the closing of the bar.
