The Traffic (Whakatane District Council) Notice No. 2, 1977

PURSUANT to the Transport Act 1962, the Minister of Transport hereby gives the following notice:

NOTICE

1. This notice may be cited as the Traffic (Whakatane District Council) Notice No. 2, 1977.

2. The roads specified in the First Schedule hereto are hereby declared to be closely populated localities for the purposes of section 52 of the Transport Act 1962.

3. The roads specified in the Second Schedule hereto are hereby declared to be 70 kilometres-an-hour speed limit areas for the purposes of regulation 21 of the Traffic Regulations 1976*.

4. The Traffic (Whakatane District) Notice No. 1, 1977, dated the 23rd day of May 1977†, under Section 52 of the Transport Act 1962, and regulation 27 of the Traffic Regulations 1976, which relates to roads situated within Whakatane District at Whakatane, is hereby revoked.

FIRST SCHEDULE

SITUATED within Whakatane District at Whakatane:

All that area bounded by a line commencing at a point where the western side of No. 2 State Highway (Pokeno-Wellington via Gisborne) crosses the southern side of the Whakatane River; thence westerly and south-easterly generally along the eastern side of the Whakatane River to a point due west of the most southern extremity of Te Tahiri Street; thence due east to the western side of No. 2 State Highway (Pokeno-Wellington via Gisborne); thence northerly generally along the western side of the said State highway to a point 40 metres measured southerly generally along the western side of the said State highway from Goulstone Street; thence at right angles across the said State highway from its western side to its eastern side; thence northerly generally along the eastern side of the said State highway to the southern side of Mokorua Gorge Road; then easterly generally along the southern side of Mokorua Gorge Road to a point 240 metres measured easterly generally along the said road from the said State highway; thence at right angles across Mokorua Gorge Road from its southern side to its northern side; thence easterly generally along the northern side of Mokorua Gorge Road to the western side of Whakatane-Kutarere Road; thence northerly generally along the western side of Whakatane-Kutarere Road to Wedgewood Place; thence due east for a distance of 640 metres; thence due north to the eastern side of the Whakatane River; thence westerly and south-westerly generally along the eastern side of the Whakatane River to the commencing point.
