Defining the Middle Line of Portions of the Dunedin-Milton Motorway in the City of Dunedin

KEITH HOLYOAKE, Governor-General A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to section 4 of the Public Works Amendment Act 1947, I, The Right Honourable Sir Keith Jacka Holyoake, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby proclaim and declare that the middle line of portions of the Dunedin-Milton Motorway shall be that defined and set forth in the First, Second and Third Schedules hereto; and I also declare that this Proclamation shall affect only the land situated within the limits of the areas shown hatched on plans SO 18810. the limits of the areas shown hatched on plans S.O. 18810. S.O. 18811, and S.O. 18812, lodged in the office of the Chief Surveyor at Dunedin.

FIRST SCHEDULE OTAGO LAND DISTRICT

COMMENCING at a point on the north-eastern boundary of Lot 3, D.P. 8809, 12 metres approximately from the easternmost corner of that lot and proceeding in a generally southwesterly direction for a distance of 52 metres approximately, passing in, into, through or over the following land, viz: Lots 3 and 2, D.P. 8809 (Better Utilisation, G.N. 433064, Gazette 1974, p. 2540); and terminating at a point on the south-western boundary of Lot 2, D.P. 8809. 24 metres approximately from the southernmost corner of the said Lot
