FIRST SCHEDULE

AREA TO BE EXCLUDED FROM OHAKUNI BOROUGH AND INCLUDED IN WAIMARINO COUNTY: S. D. WHALE PETITION

All that area in the Wellington Land District containing 83 hectares, more or less, bounded by a line commencing at the intersection of the boundary of the Borough of Ohakune as described in *New Zealand Gazette*, 1971, page 501, with the north-eastern boundary of Lot 1, D.P. 5138, and proceeding north-westerly along that boundary to the south-eastern side of Ruapehu Street; thence generally south-westerly along that side to and along the north-eastern and south-eastern boundaries of Section 83, Block V, Karioi S.D., the production of the last-mentioned boundary to the middle of the Mangateitei Stream, down the middle of that stream to the south-eastern side of Ruapehu Street, and along that side and its

AREAS TO BE EXCLUDED FROM RAETIHI BOROUGH AND INCLUDED IN WAIMARINO COUNTY: T. C. PUNCH PETITION

Firstly, all that area in the Wellington Land District containing 26.8 hectares, more or less, bounded by a line commencing at the westernmost corner of Lot 5, D.P. 3791, and proceeding northerly along the western boundary of the said Lot 5 and its production to the northern side of Ameku Road; thence generally easterly along that side to and along the north-western boundary of Lot 1, D.P. 5403, and its production to the south-western corner of Lot 1, D.P. 17486; thence northerly, westerly, southerly, and south-easterly along the boundaries of the Borough of Raetihi as described in *New Zealand Gazette*, 1921, page 3002, to the point of commencement.
