

- (b) Invite expert opinion if it so wishes, on matters of a technical nature relating to the materials and safe design and labelling of children's nightwear; and
- (c) Recommend to the Minister of Trade and Industry appropriate regulations with respect to the safety of children's nightwear.

4. In the investigation into the safety of children's nightwear the committee shall have regard to such matters as may from time to time be notified to it by the Minister of Trade and Industry.

5. The committee shall report and submit its recommendations in the form of draft regulations, to the Minister of Trade and Industry by 18 April 1977.
