A licence issued pursuant to this notification to hunt or kill game shall entitle the holder thereof to hunt or kill game in the Ashburton and South Canterbury Acclimatisation Districts, during the period and subject, *mutatis mutandis*, to the conditions prescribed in this notification fixing an open season for game in those districts.

Part property of Messrs Hill Bros., at Ngahere, all that area situated in Block VII, Mawheranui S.D., being parts of sections 55, 46, 1254, 33A, and 34, and bounded by the old main road to Reefton from the southern end of the swing bridge over Nelson Creek and along that road to the south-western boundary of Section 34 and along that boundary to the Greymouth-Inangahua State Highway and along that highway to Cemetery Road and along that road and a right projection of that road to the Greymouth-Reefton railway and along the railway to the southern end of the swing bridge, the point of commencement.

No. (4). 2. No person shall, on the waters of Lake Mahinapua, for the purpose of hunting or killing game, use any fixed stand, pontoon, hide, maimai, or loo, except within 45 metres from the margin of the lake waters.
