STATEMENT OF ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The general accounting principles outlined in the New Zealand Society of Accountants' 1974 statement for the measurement and reporting of profits and losses under the historical cost method have been adopted in the preparation of these financial statements. The following particular accounting policies which materially affects the measurement of profit and of financial position has been applied and is unchanged from last year.

- a. *Depreciation:*  
Depreciation has been calculated at rates laid down by the Inland Revenue Department.
- b. *Scientific Equipment:*  
Accounting for purchases of scientific equipment is dealt with on the basis of Government Accounting Policies.
