Poisons Regulations 1964—Approval of Alternative Form of Record

NOTICE is hereby given that pursuant to regulation 61 of the Poisons Regulations 1964*, the Registrar has approved a record in the form of an individual patient-card index, of the dispensing or supply on prescription of any poison as a medicine, such record being made and maintained in accordance with the system hereinafter described:

1. An individual card shall be allocated either to each patient or family, and be filed in alphabetical and numerical sequence in an appropriate metal filing cabinet.

2. Where a patient's surname is repeated, the cards shall be filed alphabetically by way of each patient's address.

3. This card system shall be supplemented by a separate day book, which will provide a cross reference, by recording serially by number, the patient's surname to which that number applies.

4. A separate record is to be maintained, of the dispensing or supply on prescription of any Class B Controlled Drug, as required by regulations 37 or 39 of the Misuse of Drugs Regulations 1977†.
