

Survey District, to the left bank of the Ohautira River; thence westerly generally along the line of mean high-water of that river and the Raglan Harbour to the sea coast; thence generally northerly along the sea coast to the point of commencement.

HAURAKI

ALL that area bounded by a line commencing at the confluence of the Maramarua River and the Kopuku Stream in Block III, Maramarua Survey District, being a point on the generally southern boundary of Hunua Electorate as hereinbefore described; and proceeding generally easterly along that boundary to the sea coast; thence generally easterly, generally northerly, and generally southerly along the said sea coast to the middle of the mouth of the Otahu River; thence generally south-westerly up the middle of the Otahu River to its source; thence westerly along a right line between the said source and the source of the Waipaheke Stream situated in Block VI, Ohinemuri Survey District, to its intersection with the south-western boundary of Section 2, Block II, Ohinemuri Survey District; thence south-easterly along a right line to the northernmost corner of Section 6, Block VI, Ohinemuri Survey District (State forest reserve, *Gazette*, 1938, page 277); thence generally southerly along the generally eastern boundary of Section 6, aforesaid, to and westerly and generally south-westerly along the northern and generally north-western boundaries of Section 15, Block VI, Ohinemuri Survey District, and that boundary produced to the generally south-western side of a public road, being a point on the generally south-eastern boundary of State forest reserve (*Gazette*, 1935, page 2736); thence generally south-westerly along that boundary, to and generally southerly along the generally eastern boundaries of Section 13, the eastern end of a public road, Sections 14 and 3, Block X, Ohinemuri Survey District, to and south-easterly, south-westerly, and north-westerly along the north-eastern, south-eastern, and south-western boundaries of Section 19, Block XIV, Ohinemuri Survey District, twice crossing a public road, to the south-eastern boundary of Section 3, aforesaid; thence south-westerly along that boundary to a point in line with the generally western boundary of State forest (*Gazette*, 1970, page 1596); thence to and generally southerly along that boundary to the northernmost corner of Section 76, Block XIII, Ohinemuri Survey District (State forest, *Gazette*, 1970, page 1596); thence generally southerly along the generally eastern boundaries of Section 76, aforesaid, and Section 38, Block XIV, Ohinemuri Survey District, and that last-mentioned boundary produced to the middle of Rahu Road; thence generally south-easterly along the middle line of that road to a point in line with the eastern boundary of Section 62, Block II, Aroha Survey District; thence due south along a right line to the middle of the Ohinemuri River; thence down the middle of that river to the eastern boundary of Block I, Aroha Survey District, 385 496.40 metres east of the false origin of Mount Eden Meridional Circuit; thence southerly along the eastern boundary of Block I, aforesaid, to the easternmost corner of Lot 1, D.P. S. 9393; thence easterly along the western and southern boundaries of Section 94, Block II, Aroha Survey District, to and southerly up the middle of the Mangakino Stream to a point on the north-western boundary of the Kaimai-Mamaku State Forest Park, shown on S.O. 48402 (*Gazette*, 1975, page 2328); thence along the aforesaid boundary to Trig. Station No. 567 (Te Aroha) in Block X, Aroha Survey District; thence due westerly along a right line to the western boundary of the State forest reserve, Block X, Aroha Survey District; thence southerly along the aforesaid boundary to the intersection with Section 14C, Block IX, Aroha Survey District; thence south-easterly along the north-eastern boundaries of Section 141, Block IX, Aroha Survey District, Sections 14E, 14F, 14G, 14H, Block IX, Aroha Survey District; and south-westerly along the south-eastern boundary of Section 14H to the middle of the Hachanga Stream; thence south-westerly down the middle of the aforesaid stream to its confluence with the Waihou River; thence north-westerly down the middle of that river to a point in line with the south-eastern boundary of part Section 128, Block IX, Aroha Survey District; thence south-westerly to and along the aforesaid boundary and north-westerly along the south-western boundaries of that Section and Lots 3, 2, and 1, D.P. 27037, to a point in line with the northern side of Waihou Road; thence south-westerly along the aforesaid roadside to the south-western corner of Lot 26, D.P. 14475; thence north-westerly along the north-eastern boundary of Section 88, Block IX, Aroha Survey District, and its production across Gordon Avenue to the middle of the Thames Branch Railway; thence south-westerly along the middle of the said railway to a point in line with the middle of Gould Road; thence northerly along the middle of that road to a point in line with

the northern boundary of Lot 3, D.P. 23932; thence westerly to and along that boundary and the northern boundaries of Lots 2 and 1, D.P. S. 8495, and the last-mentioned boundary produced to the middle of Ngutumanga Road; thence southerly along the middle of that road to its intersection with the middle of Bailey Road; thence generally south-westerly along the middle of the said Bailey Road, Eastport Road, Number 2 Road, and State Highway No. 27 (Number 8 Road), to a point in line with the southern boundary of Lot 6, D.P. 4522, situated in Block III, Maungakawa Survey District; thence westerly to and along that boundary and the northern boundaries of Lot 4, D.P. 13494, and Lot 2, D.P. 31807, and the last-mentioned boundary produced to the middle of the Waiharakeke West Stream; thence north-westerly down the middle of that stream to its confluence with the Piako River; thence southerly up the middle of that river to the middle of Haumia Road; thence generally south-westerly along the middle of that Road, Mangateparu Loop Road, and Tahuna Morrinsville Road to a point in line with the northern boundary of Section 7, Block I, Maungakawa Survey District; thence generally westerly to and along that boundary, the northern and western boundaries of Section 5, Block I, aforesaid, the western boundary of Section 6, Block I, aforesaid, the middle of a drain forming the southern boundary of Lot 4, D.P. 35343, passing through Sections 4 and 3, Block I, aforesaid, forming the northern boundary of Lot 1, D.P. 12423, and passing through Lot 2, D.P. 12423, to the middle of Tauhei Motumaoho Road; thence southerly along the middle of that road to the middle of Reay and Watson Road; thence westerly along the middle of that road and the eastern and northern boundaries of Lot 6, D.P. 12470, to the north-western corner of that lot; thence northerly along the western boundaries of Lots 2 and 1, D.P. 13235, Lots 2 and 1, D.P. 11983, and part Lot 6, D.P. 11661, along a right line to and along the western boundaries of Lot 1, D.P. 8138, Lots 3 and 4, D.P. S. 862, and Lot 1, D.P. 29197, along a right line to and along the western boundaries of part Hoe-O-Tainui South No. 1A1 and 1A2 and Section 15, Block XII, Hapuakohe Survey District, along a right line across Tainui Road to and along the western boundaries of Sections 16, 17, and 18, Block XII, aforesaid, Lot 1, D.P. S. 5428, and Lots 8 and 6, D.P. 13199, along a right line across the Mangawhara Stream to and along the western boundary of Hoe-O-Tainui North, 5A North 2B, along a right line to and again along the western boundary of Hoe-O-Tainui North 5A, North 2B, and along the western boundaries of Hoe-O-Tainui North 5A, North No. 2A1, to and along the generally eastern boundary of Rangiriri Electorate as hereinbefore described; to the point of commencement; including therein Waimate, Whanganui, Rangipukea and Cuvier Islands, the Mercury group of islands, the Alderman Islands, Shoe and Slipper Islands, and other islands adjoining these and the area described herein.

HAMILTON WEST

ALL that area bounded by a line commencing at the north-western corner of Lot 6, D.P. S. 9015, situated in Block I, Hamilton Survey District, being a point on the boundary of Hamilton City as described in *Gazette*, 1965, page 172, and proceeding easterly along the northern boundary of that lot and its production to the middle of Newcastle Road; thence generally north-easterly along the middle of that road, Ellicott Road, Forest Lake Road, and Tui Avenue to a point in line with the south-eastern boundary of the former Lot 7, D.P. 8639; thence generally north-easterly to and along that boundary, the eastern boundary of the said Lot 7 and the south-eastern boundaries of the former Lots 5, 4, and 3, D.P. 8639, to the southern side of Mitcham Avenue; thence north-easterly along a right line to the western corner of Lot 1, D.P. S. 6605; thence generally northerly along the generally eastern and the north-eastern boundaries of Lot 1, D.P. S. 17179, to a point in line with the south-eastern boundary of Lot 1, D.P. 30667; thence north-easterly and north-westerly to and along that boundary and the north-eastern boundaries of that lot and Lot 3, D.P. S. 192, to a point in line with the north-western boundary of Lot 1, D.P. 35395; thence north-easterly to and along that boundary and its production to the middle of State Highway No. 1 (Te Rapa Road); thence generally north-easterly along the middle of the said highway, Vardon Road, Taylor Terrace, Beerescourt Road, and Minchin Crescent to and along the northern boundary of Lot 11, D.P. S. 379, and that boundary produced to the middle of the Waikato River; thence generally south-easterly up the middle of that river to its confluence with the Mangakotukutuku Stream and up the middle of the Mangakotukutuku Stream to the intersection of the north-eastern side of Peacocks Road, in Block II, Hamilton Survey District; thence south-easterly along the said roadside to a point 45 metres from and measured north-westerly at right angles
