SPECIAL ORDER

SPECIAL ORDER of the Paparua County Council, made by the passing of a resolution at a special meeting of the Council held in the Council Chambers, Sockburn, on Monday, 4 April 1977, and confirmed at an ordinary meeting held in the Council Chambers, Sockburn, on Monday 2 May 1977.

RESOLVED:

That the following adjustments be made to the riding boundaries within the county:

(a) Yaldhurst/Hornby/Sockburn Boundary

The existing boundary presently lying a section depth along the north side of Buchanans Road be repositioned along the centre-line of Buchanans Road from the point where the boundary crosses Buchanans Road in a westerly direction to Gilberthorpes Road

NOTE: This will result in the properties encompassed within the narrow strip along Buchanans Road being transferred from Hornby to Yaldhurst riding. In addition a further small alteration is required where the joint boundary crosses Buchanans
