 (f) One member elected by the parents of the pupils attending the school, being parents who are resident in the Pukeora School district, the Takapau School district, the Marakeke School district, the Hatuma School district, the Wallingford School district, the Flemington School district, the Porangahau School district the Wilder School district the Oueroa riemington School district, the Porangahau School district, the Wilder School district, the Oueroa School district, the Ponana School district, the Omakere School district, the Punawaitai School district, the Ashley Clinton School district, the Makaretu North School district, the Orapa School district, or the Mangaorapa School district;
