The Secondary School Grants Notice (No. 2) 1977

PURSUANT to regulation 3 of the Secondary School Grants Regulations 1974, and a determination jointly made by the Minister of Education and the Minister of Finance, the Minister of Education hereby gives the following notice:

NOTICE

1. This notice may be cited as the Secondary School Grants Notice (No. 2) 1977.

2 For the period 1 February 1976 to 31 March 1977, the basis of calculating the amount of grants made for general administration to the governing body of any school in accordance with the provisions of the Secondary School Grants Regulations 1974 shall be as follows:

(a) A grant payable in accordance with paragraph (a) of regulation 4 of the said regulations in respect of the number of pupils enrolled in each school under the control of the governing body shall be calculated as follows:
