Notice of Intention to Vary Hours of Sale of Liquor at Licensed Premises—Taranaki Licensing Committee

PURSUANT to section 221A (16) of the Sale of Liquor Act 1962, as amended by the Sale of Liquor Amendment Act 1976, I, Gordon Stewart Orr, Secretary for Justice, hereby

give notice that the Taranaki Licensing Committee on 22 June 1977 made an order authorising variations of the usual hours for the sale of liquor to the public, and further authorised the following hours of trading for the licensed premises known as Lion Tavern, New Plymouth:

- On every Saturday (not being Christmas Eve or New Year's Eve nor a day when licensed premises are required to be closed for the sale of liquor to the general public) the hour of closing for the Lounge Bar only shall be 11 o'clock in the evening.
- On every Christmas Eve (not being a day when licensed premises are required to be closed for the sale of liquor to the general public) the hour of closing for all bars on the premises shall be 11 o'clock in the evening.
- On every New Year's Eve/New Year's Day (not being days when licensed premises are required to be closed for the sale of liquor to the general public) the hour of closing shall be 0.30 o'clock in the morning of New Year's Day.
- Adequate food is to be available for patrons until 10.45 o'clock in the evening.

Notice of Intention to Vary Hours of Sale of Liquor at Chartered Club Premises—Southland Licensing Committee

PURSUANT to section 221A (16) of the Sale of Liquor Act 1962, as amended by the Sale of Liquor Amendment Act 1976, I, Gordon Stewart Orr, Secretary for Justice, hereby give notice that the Southland Licensing Committee on 29 July 1977 made an order authorising variations of the usual hours for the sale of liquor to the public, and further authorised the following hours of trading for the chartered club premises known as Southern Club Incorporated, Invercargill:

- On every Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday (not being Christmas Eve or New Year's Eve nor days when chartered clubs are required to be closed for the sale of liquor to their members) the hour of opening shall be 11 o'clock in the morning and the hour of closing 10 o'clock in the evening.
- On every Friday, Saturday, and Christmas Eve (not being days when chartered clubs are required to be closed for the sale of liquor to their members) the hour of opening shall be 11 o'clock in the morning and the hour of closing 11 o'clock in the evening.
- On every New Year's Eve (not being a day when chartered clubs are required to be closed for the sale of liquor to their members) the hour of opening shall be 11 o'clock in the morning of New Year's Eve and the hour of closing 0.30 o'clock in the morning of New Year's Day.
