Local Government Training Board Notice 1977

NOTICE

1. This notice may be cited as the Local Government Training Board Notice 1977.

2. (a) There shall be an Industrial Training Board for Local Government which shall be known as the Local Government Training Board and shall comprise the following members:

- (1) One member appointed by the Municipal Association of New Zealand (Inc.) and the New Zealand Counties' Association Inc. who shall be Chairman of the Board.
- (2) One member appointed by the Municipal Association of New Zealand (Inc.).
- (3) One member appointed by the New Zealand Counties' Association Inc.
- (4) Three members appointed by trade unions representing workers employed in local government.
- (5) One member appointed by the New Zealand Institute of Town Clerks and Municipal Treasurers Inc.
- (6) One member appointed by the New Zealand Institute of County Clerks (Inc.).
- (7) One member appointed by the Municipal Engineers' Division of the New Zealand Institute of Engineers.
- (8) One member appointed by the NZ Institute of County Engineers (Inc.).
- (9) One member appointed by the Director-General of Education.
- (10) One member appointed by the Secretary for Local Government.
- (11) One member appointed by the Chief Executive Officer of the Vocational Training Council.
 - (b) In addition to the members specified in sub-clause (a) of this notice, the board may from time to time as it sees fit co-opt not more than four additional members.
