Defining the Middle Line of Portions of the Timaru-Milton and Blenheim-Invercargill via Nelson and Greymouth State Highways in the Borough of Cromwell and the County of Vincent

DENIS BLUNDELL, Governor-General A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to the Public Works Act 1928, I, Sir Edward Denis Blundell, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby proclaim and declare that the middle line of a road desired to be constructed in the Borough of Cromwell and County of Vincent, viz, a deviation of the Timaru-Milton and Blenheim-Invercargill via Nelson and Greymouth State highways shall be that defined and set forth in the Schedule hereto; and I also declare that this Proclamation shall affect only the land situated within the limits of the area shown shaded on plan S.O. 18721, referred to in the Schedule hereto.
