A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to the Public Works Act 1928, I, Sir Edward Denis Blundell, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby revoke the Proclamation dated the 30th day of May 1974, and published in the *New Zealand Gazette*, 6 June 1974, Volume II, page 1120, taking land, subject to the mining easement created by conveyance 326244 (R. 424/27) and the drainage easements created by transfers S. 203477, S. 203480, S. 203483, S. 203486, S. 206396, S. 218862, S. 218865, S. 218868, S. 222176, S. 223001, S. 229437, S. 229439, S. 234661, S. 239014, S. 241478, S. 241200, S. 242684, S. 249157, and S. 262471, South Auckland Land Registry, for the generation of electricity in so far as it affects the land described in the Schedule hereto.
