PURSUANT to sections 8A and 165 of the Harbours Act 1950, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. (a) This order may be cited as the Port Waikato Order 1977.

(b) This order shall come into force on the date of its publication in the Gazette.

2. In this order— "The Act" means the Harbours Act 1950:

"The Council" means the Raglan County Council:

"Foreshore" means such parts of the bed, shore, or banks of a tidal water as are covered and uncovered by the ebb and flow of the tide at ordinary spring tides:

"Minister" means the Minister of Transport; and includes any officer, person or authority acting by or under the direction or authority of the Minister.

3. There is hereby granted to the Council for a period of 21 years from the commencement of this order, the control of foreshore and waters described in the First Schedule to this order, subject to the provisions of sections 8A and 165 of the Act, and to the conditions specified in the Second Schedule to this Order.

4. The Port Waikato Order 1971* is hereby revoked.
