

Canada goose (only in the Waiau Watershed upstream from the junction of the Waiau and the Orawia Rivers, the whole of the Orawia Watershed, the Oreti Watershed upstream from the Centre Bush Bridge and the Aparima Watershed upstream from the Wreys Bush Bridge. Also in that portion of the society's district north of a straight line extending from the Lumsden road-rail bridge to East Dome on the society's eastern boundary)

15 April to 18 June 1978 incl.

Daily Bag Limits

Grey duck, 5. Pheasants, no limit.
Shoveler (or spoonbill), 5. Chukor, no limit.
Mallard duck, 15. Canada goose, no limit.
Paradise duck, 2.
Grey, shoveler (or spoonbill), paradise, and mallard duck, 15 in all.

Shooting hours: 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.

Decoy limit: No limit.

Special Conditions

1. In the Southland Acclimatisation District not more than four persons shall at any time hunt or kill or attempt to hunt or kill game over the same set of artificial decoys.

Pukeko (only in the area that lies east of State Highway No. 1 and north of the Waitaki River and in the area that lies east of the main transmission lines from Bortons through Dansey's Pass and south of the Waitaki River)	15 April to 5 June 1978 incl.

Area B, 2. Pheasants, 3.
Grey, shoveler (or spoonbill), mallard, and paradise duck, 25 in all.

Shooting hours: 6.30 a.m. to 7.00 p.m. except that during the period 19 June 1978 to 29 October 1978 inclusive, and midnight 2 February 1979 to 25 March 1979 at midnight inclusive, Canada goose may be hunted or killed 24 hours per day.

Decoy limit: No limit.

Special Conditions

1. No person shall, for the purposes of hunting or killing game, build, or attempt to build, any stand, hide, shelter, maimai, mud-hold, loo, louvre, or position before 9 a.m. on 18 March 1978.

No person shall, on the waters of Lake Mahinapua, for the purpose of hunting or killing game, use any fixed stand, pontoon, hide, maimai, or loo, except within 45 metres from the margin of the lake waters.

Approval to Hunt or Kill Game during an Open Season for Game where Food has been Cast, Thrown, Placed or Planted
