PURSUANT to the Transport Act 1962, the Minister of Transport hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

1. This notice may be cited as the Traffic (Waimairi County) Notice No. 1 1978.

2. The roads specified in the First Schedule hereto are hereby declared to be closely populated localities for the purposes of section 52 of the Transport Act 1962.

3. The roads specified in the Second Schedule hereto are hereby declared to be limited speed zones for the purposes of regulation 21 (4) of the Traffic Regulations 1976*.

4. The roads specified in the Third Schedule hereto are hereby declared to be 70 kilometres an hour speed limit areas for the purposes of regulation 21 of the Traffic Regulations 1976*.

5. The Traffic (Waimairi County) Notice No. 2 1974, dated the 22nd day of January 1974†, under Section 52 of the Transport Act 1962, and regulation 27 of the Traffic Regulations 1956, which relates to roads situated within Waimairi County at Marshland, Burwood, Parkland and Woodland is hereby revoked.
