A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to section 14 of the Wildlife Act 1953, I, the Right Honourable Sir Keith Jacka Holyoake, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby revoke the Proclamation issued on the 12th day of January 1967*, declaring an area of land in the Southland Acclimatisation District to be a wildlife refuge for the purposes of the Wildlife Act 1953.
