earlier distinction drawn between the two editions remains valid. As was said in decision No. 889:

"The balance between the serious and sexual content in the American edition remains more even and enables us, viewing it as a whole, to give it a restricted classification. The balance tilts sharply towards the sexual side in the English edition."

The Tribunal classifies these two issues of the English edition of *Penthouse* as indecent, and in the terms of section 15A (1) of the Act makes a restriction order in similar terms for a period of 2 years.
