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PAPATOETOE CITY COUNCIL

IN THE MATTER OF THE PUBLIC WORKS ACT 1928 AND ITS AMENDMENTS

NOTICE is hereby given that the Papatoetoe City Council proposes, under the provisions of the above-mentioned Act, to execute certain public works, namely the widening of East Tamaki Road, and for the purpose of such public work it is necessary that the land described in the Schedule hereto be taken under the above-mentioned Act.
