Special Conditions

1. No person shall use or cause to be used for the hunting or killing of game on Lake Waikare any fixed artificial stand, pontoon, hide, maimai, or loo, except within 180 metres of the outer margin of the said lake, or the shoreline of that island known as Motu Nuia or Grape Island.

2. No person shall use or cause to be used for the hunting or killing of game on Lake Ngāroto any fixed stand, pontoon, hide, maimai, or loo, except within 85 metres of the margin of the said lake.

3. No person shall use or cause to be used for the hunting or killing of game on Lake Rotokauri any fixed stand, pontoon, hide, maimai, or loo, on any open water of the said lake.

4. It shall be an offence for any person to wilfully leave any black swan(s) shot or the mutilated bodies of any black swan(s) shot in the Auckland Acclimatisation District.

5. It shall be an offence for any person to drive black swan(s) for the purpose of hunting or killing them in the Auckland Acclimatisation District.

6. It shall be an offence to shoot game from drifting or hand propelled boats on the Waikato River north of the boat ramp at the confluence of the Mangawara Stream and the Waikato River at Taupiri on any of the first 3 days or the second weekend of the open season.
