1. In the Tauranga Harbour no maimai shall be erected that will impede the use of navigable channels and waters of the harbour.

2. Maimais erected in the Tauranga Harbour must be dismantled and removed at the close of the season.

The Traffic (MacKenzie County and Waitaki County) Notice No. 1 1978

PURSUANT to the Transport Act 1962, the Minister of Transport hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

1. This notice may be cited as the Traffic (MacKenzie County and Waitaki County) Notice No. 1, 1978.

2. The road, specified in the Schedule hereto, is hereby declared to be a 70 kilometres an hour speed limit area for the purposes of regulation 21 of the Traffic Regulation 1976*.

3. The Traffic (MacKenzie County) Notice No. 3, 1977 dated the 21st day of December 1977†, under section 52 of the Transport Act 1962, and regulation 27 of the Traffic Regulations 1976*, which relates to a road situated within MacKenzie County at the Ohau River Bridge, is hereby revoked.
