21. Miscellaneous Concessions—continued

(c) *Restrictions*—Tickets at section 3 fares less 10 percent are not available on the *Silver Star* sleeper train service during the following periods—

- (i) Queen's Birthday and Labour Day.
- (ii) Easter weekend, from Thursday to the following Tuesday inclusive.
- (iii) Over the Christmas and New Year holiday period.
- (iv) Other public holidays.

Note: Concession tickets are not available for travel by the "*Silver Fern*" railcar services.
 (d) Tickets issued under the provisions of this section must be purchased not later than 30 minutes before the departure time of the train service for which such tickets are to be used. The department reserves the right to decline any application for tickets under the provisions of this section.

2. Concession fares in terms of this section may be granted on application, as follows:

In such cases the minimum number travelling will be equivalent to six adult passengers.</p>
