PURSUANT to the Hydatids Act 1968, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. (i) This order may be cited as the Waipawa Hydatids Control District Order 1978.

(ii) This order shall come into force on 1 April 1978.

2. The area comprising the Waipawa District, as from time to time constituted, is hereby declared a hydatids control district to be called the Waipawa Hydatids Control District.
