New Zealand - Australia Free Trade Agreement

Application for the Approval of Goods as Determined Imported Materials—Notice 1978/3

NOTICE is hereby given that application has been made to Australia for the approval of the goods, described in the Schedule hereto, as determined imported materials in accordance with Australian legislation relating to the rules governing the origin of goods "wholly manufactured".

Submissions should include a reference to the application number, Tariff item, and description of the goods concerned, be addressed to the Comptroller of Customs, Private Bag, Wellington, and supported by information as to the quality, range, supply, etc., of the goods or suitable alternative goods produced in New Zealand.
