Declaration that Land Shall be a Walkway

PURSUANT to the New Zealand Walkways Act 1975, the Minister of Lands hereby declares that the land, described in the Schedule hereto, shall be a walkway, and shall hereafter be known as the Hakarimata Walkway.

SOUTH AUCKLAND LAND DISTRICT

RAGLAN COUNTY—HAKARIMATA WALKWAY

COMMENCING at a point on the side of Parker Road adjoining Part Allotment 223, Pepepe Parish, shown marked A, and thence proceeding, generally, southwards over the said Part Allotment 223 and an unformed public road situated in Block III, Newcastle Survey District, to terminate at a point at the intersection of two unformed roads shown marked B, as the same is more particularly delineated on survey office plan 49420.
