

*Declaring Land and an Easement Over Land Taken for Harbour Works in the City of Auckland*

PURSUANT to section 32 of the Public Works Act 1928 and section 35 of the Finance Act (No. 2) 1945, the Minister of Works and Development hereby declares that, a sufficient agreement to that effect having been entered into, the land described in the First Schedule hereto is hereby taken for harbour works and shall vest in the Auckland Harbour Board, and a right of way easement appurtenant to the land described in the said First Schedule is hereby taken over the land described in the Second Schedule hereto for harbour works, vesting in the Auckland Harbour Board and its servants, tenants, agents, workmen, and invitees the free and perpetual right from time to time and at all times by day and by night to go, pass and repass, with or without carriages, vehicles, motor vehicle machinery, animals and implements, all of any kind, over and along the land described in the said Second Schedule, from and after the 11th day of January 1979.
