A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to section 421 of the Maori Affairs Act 1953, I, The Right Honourable Sir Keith Jacka Holyoake, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby declare the land described in the Schedule hereto, and comprised in a roadway laid out by the Maori Land Court by an order dated the 29th day of June 1910, to be road, and to be vested in the Horowhenua County Council.

ALL that piece of land containing 2163 square metres, situated in Block IV, Moutere Survey District, and being Lot 38, L.T. plan 50181.

A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to section 14 of the Wildlife Act 1953, I, the Right Honourable Sir Keith Jacka Holyoake, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby revoke the Proclamation issued on 14 November 1963, *Gazette*, No. 74, p. 1835, declaring an area of land in the Lower Wanaka Survey District and in the Southern Lakes Acclimatisation District, described in the Schedule hereto, to be a wildlife refuge for the purposes of the Wildlife Act 1953.
