PURSUANT to section 221A of the Sale of Liquor Act 1962, as amended by section 22 (14) of the Sale of Liquor Amendment Act 1976, I, Bruce James Cameron, Acting Secretary for Justice, hereby give notice that the Wanganui Licensing Committee, on 20 December 1978, made an order authorising variations of the usual hours of trading for the licensed premises known as the Imperial Hotel, at Wanganui.
