# SECOND SCHEDULE

- 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of this notice, no person who is permitted by any such provision to propel or navigate a small craft at a speed through the water exceeding 5 knots shall do so in any manner that is likely to endanger or unduly annoy any person who is on, in, or using the water, or fishing or undertaking any recreational activity in the vicinity of the small craft.
- 2. No person shall enter any area of state forest without first obtaining the written consent of the Conservator of Forests or other lawful authority for the area concerned.
- 3. The river shall not be used as access to the Waiouru Army Training Area. Persons shall restrict themselves to the riverbed or to the eastern side of the river in this area.
- 4. All persons in charge of a vessel shall adhere to and keep the provisions of all other Acts and regulations not specifically exempted by this notice.
