Approval of Revolving Amber Lights for Certain Vehicles

PURSUANT to subclause (8) of regulation 67 of the Traffic Regulations 1976*, the Secretary for Transport hereby approves the fitting of one or two revolving or flashing amber lights on Automobile Association patrol vehicles. This approval is subject to the following conditions:

1. The vehicle is painted a conspicuous colour.
2. The lights are only used while the vehicle is stationary and unable to avoid creating a hazard in the performance of its duties.
3. The lights are placed in such a position on the vehicle so as to obtain maximum visibility while the vehicle is causing a traffic hazard.
4. Unless traffic is under the control of a police officer or traffic officer, adequate warning signs shall be erected as soon as practicable in advance of any hazard indicated by revolving or flashing amber lights.
